WHEREAS, the Village Board has been informed by the Village Engineer MHE Engineering that the Village's Stormwater Management Code (Village Code, Chapter 96) needs to be revised to reflect the 2024 NYSDEC SPDES General Permit for Stormwater discharges from separate municipal storm sewer systems ("MS4"); and

WHEREAS, the Village Board desires the Village Engineering firm of MHE Engineering in consultation with Village legal counsel, to draft such revisions to the Code as needed and to receive input from the public concerning such revisions.

- Section 2. The Village Board hereby schedules a public hearing on August 21, 2024 at 6:00 p.m. or as soon thereafter as can be heard, to consider amendments to Chapter 96 of the Village Stormwater Management Code.
